SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT DATED AS OF SEPTEMBER 24, 1987
TO EQUIPMENT TRUST AGREEMENT DATED AS OF MAY 15, 1978

BY AND BETWEEN

CITIBANK, N.A. TRUSTEE

AND

GENERAL AMERICAN TRANSPORTATION CORPORATION

Supplemental Agreement dated as of September 24, 1987 by and between Citibank, N.A., as Trustee, and General American Transportation Corporation, a New York corporation.

Whereas, the parties hereto entered into an Equipment Trust Agreement dated as of May 15, 1978 (the "Agreement") creating General American Transportation Corporation Equipment Trust, Series 75, which Agreement was filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to Section 20 of the Interstate Commerce Act on May 15, 1978, Recordation No. 9375; and

Whereas, the parties hereto wish to amend Schedule A to the Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree that Schedule A to the Agreement is hereby amended by:

(a) deleting therefrom the units of Trust Equipment described in Schedule I attached hereto, and

(b) substituting therefor the units of Equipment described in Schedule II attached hereto.


