DATED AS OF MARCH 30, 1981

TO
SECURITY AGREEMENT
DATED AS OF DECEMBER 1, 1980

BETWEEN

WATERLOO RAILROAD COMPANY

AND

THE FIDELITY BANK

THIS SUPPLEMENT, dated as of March 30, 1981, by and between WATERLOO RAILROAD COMPANY an Iowa corporation (herein called the "Company"), having its office at 233 North Michigan Avenue, Chicago, Illinois 60601, and THE FIDELITY BANK (herein called the "Bank"), having its office at Broad & Walnut Streets, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19109.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of a certain Security Agreement dated as of December 1, 1980 (herein called the "Agreement") between the Company and the Bank recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission on December 11, 1980, No. 12567, a security interest in certain railroad Equipment described in Schedule I to said Agreement was granted by the Company to the Bank; and

WHEREAS, it was contemplated that certain additional Equipment would be added to the Agreement from time to time by means of Supplementary Schedules thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement was supplemented by Supplements dated as of January 23, 1981 and March 6, 1981 and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission, No. 12567-A and 12567-B, respectively:

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Company agrees with the Bank as follows:

1. As security for all Liabilities, as said term is defined in the Agreement, the Company hereby mortgages, transfers and assigns to the Bank a continuing security interest in and to all right, title and interest whatsoever of the Company in and to the additional Equipment shown on Supplementary Schedule No. 3 hereto.

2. In all other respects the Agreement shall remain in effect between the parties thereto.

3. This Supplement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original, and all of which shall together constitute but one and the same instrument.
