

AMENDMENT TO SECURITY AGREEMENT

This Amendment to Security Agreement dated as of the 28th day of January, 1981 by and between Patricia J. Cooper, formerly known as Patricia J. Christenson, whose address is 414 South Main Street, Roswell, New Mexico, 88201 (the "Debtor") and First National Bank in Albuquerque, a national banking association organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the United States of America, whose address is P.O. Box 1305, Albuquerque, New Mexico, 87102 (the "Secured Party").

WITNESSETH:

1. Debtor and Secured Party have previously entered in that certain security agreement described on Schedule "A" attached hereto (the "Security Agreement") whereby the Debtor granted to the Secured Party a security interest in and to each of those railroad cars described on Schedule "B" attached hereto (the "Collateral").
2. By Bill of Sale of even date herewith, Debtor has transferred and conveyed the Collateral to Johnson Enterprises Limited Partnership, a New Mexico limited partnership, which has assumed all obligations of the Debtor under the Security Agreement.
3. Debtor hereby acknowledges that the Security Agreement creates a first and prior security interest in the Collateral which security interest shall not be impaired by any transfer or conveyance of the Collateral to Johnson Enterprises Limited Partnership.
4. Debtor hereby authorizes the Secured Party, in its absolute discretion, to extend and renew any or all of the obligations secured by the Security Agreement in the name of Johnson Enterprises Limited Partnership, without further notice to or the consent of Debtor and Debtor hereby agrees that the Security Agreement and the Collateral shall continue in full force and effect and shall stand as security for any such extended or renewed obligations.
5. To better evidence and perfect the interest of the Secured Party in and to the Collateral, the Secured Party and Johnson Enterprises Limited Partnership have by instrument of even date herewith entered into a security agreement whereby Johnson Enterprises Limited Partnership has granted the Secured

by authority of its Board of Directors, and he acknowledged that the execution of the foregoing instrument was the free act and deed of said corporation.
