We transmit to you herewith by registered mail for recordation, pursuant to 49 U.S.C. Section 11303, an original and two certified counterparts of the Second Supplemental Equipment Trust Agreement (the "Supplemental Agreement"), dated October 1, 1982, by and between Union Tank Car Company, 39 S. LaSalle St., Chicago, IL, 60603 (the "Company") and Manufacturers Hanover Trust Company, 40 Wall Street, New York, NY 10015 (the "Bank") as Trustee, which amends the Equipment Trust Agreement dated as of January 15, 1981, between the Company and the Bank. THIS SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL EQUIPMENT TRUST AGREEMENT dated as of October 1, 1982 (the "Supplement"), by and between UNION TANK CAR COMPANY, a Delaware corporation incorporated on September 23, 1980 (the "Company") and the successor to Union Tank Car Company, a Delaware corporation incorporated on January 22, 1968 ("Union"), and Manufacturers Hanover Trust Company, as Trustee (the "Trustee").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Union has heretofore executed and delivered to the Trustee an Equipment Trust Agreement dated as of January 15, 1981, (the "Trust Agreement"), providing for an issue of its Equipment Trust Certificates (Series 18) (the "Trust Certificates"); and

WHEREAS, the aggregate final Cost (as defined in the Trust Agreement) of the Equipment heretofore transferred to the Trustee pursuant to Section 4.04 of the Trust Agreement has been determined to be less than 133-1/3% of the aggregate principal amount of Trust Certificates issued pursuant to Section 2.01 of the Trust Agreement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Section 4.04, Union desires to transfer and convey to the Trustee additional Equipment in such amount and of such Cost that the final Cost of the Trust Equipment will be at least 133-1/3% of the aggregate principal amount of said Trust Certificates; and

WHEREAS, the Company desires to comply with Section 5.03 of the Trust Agreement by the execution of a supplement thereto, to evidence the inclusion of the aforesaid Equipment as a part of the Trust Equipment under the Trust Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and for other valuable consideration, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the Company covenants and agrees with the Trustee for the equal and proportionate benefit of the respective holders from time to time of the Trust Certificates, as follows:

ARTICLE ONE

Addition of Equipment

The equipment described in Schedule A annexed hereto is hereby added to and included as part of the Trust Equipment under the Trust Agreement and is and shall be subject to all the terms and conditions of the Trust Agreement in all respects as though it had been part of the Trust Equipment specifically described in the Trust Agreement.

ARTICLE TWO

Concerning the Trustee

The Trustee accepts the provisions of this Supplement but only upon the terms and conditions set forth in the Trust Agreement. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Trustee assumes no responsibility for the correctness of the recitals herein contained, which shall be taken as the statements of the Company. The Trustee makes no representations and shall have no responsibility as to the validity of this Supplement.

ARTICLE THREE

Miscellaneous Provisions

Except as hereby expressly provided, the Trust Agreement is in all respects ratified and confirmed and all the terms, provisions and conditions thereof shall be and remain in full force and effect.

This Supplement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be an original, but such counterparts shall together constitute but one and the same instrument.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Company and the Trustee have caused this Supplement to be duly executed by their respective officers thereunto duly authorized and their respective corporate seals, duly attested, to be hereunto affixed, all as of the date and year first above written.
