PARTIAL TERMINATION OF LEASE AGREEMENT INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Transportation Corporation of America, an Illinois Corporation ("TCA") and Minneapolis, Northfield and Southern Railway, Inc., a Minnesota Corporation ("MNS") entered into a Lease Agreement dated as of January 6, 1981 which was recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission on February 11, 1981 under recordation No. 12922, and thereafter amended by Rider No. 1 which was recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission on February 11, 1981 under recordation No. 12922A, and was also amended by Rider No. 2 which was recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission on May 18, 1981 under recordation No. 12922B ("Lease Agreement");

WHEREAS, TCA and MNS intend that the hereinafter described portion of the railway equipment which is the subject of said Lease Agreement, be excluded and removed from the terms, provisions and effect of that Lease Agreement.

THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by both of the parties hereto, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. That as to the following described units of railway equipment the Lease Agreement is terminated and those following described units of railway equipment are hereby excluded and removed from the terms, provisions and effects of the Lease Agreement:

100	100 Ton, 4750 cu. ft. covered hopper cars	MNS 3100 through MNS 3199 (both inclusive)

2. That as to all other units of railway equipment which are the subject of the Lease Agreement, that Lease Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

3. That this Partial Termination of Lease Agreement is effective as of August 1, 1981.






