

LEASE TERMINATION AGREEMENT

in consideration of their mutual promises and other good and valuable consideration, Transportation Corporation of America, an Illinois corporation, (hereinafter called "TCA") and Columbia & Cowlitz Railway Company, a Washington corporation, (hereinafter called Columbia) hereby mutually agree to terminate the Lease Agreement dated as of June 23, 1972, between TCA, as Lessor, and Columbia, as Lessee, pertaining to the following described railroad equipment:


