





NOTICE OF RENUMBERING

INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

RECITALS:

1. Manufacturers National Bank of Detroit, as Vendor, and the Detroit, Toledo and Ironton Railroad Company ("DT&I"), as Vendee, entered into a conditional sale agreement ("CSA") dated as of September 7, 1972, for the conditional sale of eight locomotives, which CSA was recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission on September 14, 1972, and assigned recordation No. 6738.

2. Said locomotives are GP 40-2 diesel electric locomotives, numbered 406 through 413, both inclusive.

3. Pursuant to said CSA, Section 4.5, DT&I may renumber said locomotives by giving notice to the vendor of renumbering and recording the new numbers in those offices where the original agreement was recorded.

NOW, THEREFORE, DT&I serves notice that said locomotives will be renumbered as shown on Schedule A, attached hereto and made a part hereof but the locomotives shall otherwise remain subject to all the terms and conditions of the above referenced agreement.
