

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT the undersigned, EMONS RAILCAR CORP., a New York corporation (the "Company"), is the owner of the full, legal and beneficial title to the following equipment:

twenty-nine seventy ton, fifty foot boxcars bearing the following markings: MPA 37971 through 37999, inclusive.

THAT for and in consideration of good and valuable consideration in addition to the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), the Company does this 1st day of April 1981 grant, convey, transfer, bargain and sell, deliver and set over all of its right, title and interest in and to the above described equipment unto The Chase Manhattan Bank (National Association), as Trustee, owner and lessor, under the Equipment Trust Agreement dated as of April 1, 1979 between said Trustee and Emons Industries, Inc., and to said Trustee's successors and assigns forever.

THAT the Company hereby warrants to the said Trustee, its successors and assigns that there is hereby vested in said Trustee good and marketable title to the said equipment free and clear of all liens, security interests, claims, and encumbrances and rights of others (except the rights of Emons Industries, Inc. under the said Equipment Trust Agreement) and the Company agrees with said Trustee, its successors and assigns, that it will warrant and defend such title forever against all claims and demands whatsoever.
