

TRANSFER AGREEMENT

INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

WHEREAS, on October 20, 1980, AMERICAN GRAIN AND RELATED INDUSTRIES (A FARMER-OWNED COOPERATIVE), West Des Moines, Iowa, as Debtor, executed a Security Agreement on One hundred (100) Pullman Standard Lot No. 1122 100-ton covered hopper cars, bearing car identifications ALEX1100 through ALEX1199, to OMAHA BANK FOR COOPERATIVES, a corporation incorporated under the laws of the United States of America, 800 Farm Credit Building, 206 South 19th Street, Omaha, Nebraska, as Secured Party, which Security Agreement was filed in the office of the Interstate Commerce Commission as Instrument No. 13138, on June 16, 1981, at 10:00 a.m.

WHEREAS, subsequently the Debtor above named transferred title to said railroad hopper cars to AGRI Industries Leasing Company, 1605 19th Street S.W., Mason City, Iowa (a subsidiary of American Grain and Related Industries), as part of a financing transaction between said parties; and,

WHEREAS, AGRI Industries Leasing Company transferred title to said railroad hopper cars to AGRI Financial Services, Inc. (d/b/a Agri Leasit Company), (also a subsidiary of American Grain and Related Industries); and,

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto desire to evidence the transfer of the railroad hopper cars itemized in the Security Agreement dated October 20, 1980, filed in the office of the Interstate Commerce Commission as Instrument No. 13138 on June 16, 1981, at 10:00 a.m., to AGRI Financial Services, Inc.


