
WHEREAS, pursuant to the Agreement, Trustee has sold to the F&P the Railcars described on Appendix A, Part 1, hereto (the "Railcars");

This Bill of Sale is delivered pursuant to the terms and conditions of the aforesaid Agreement, which terms and conditions shall survive the delivery hereof and shall not merge into this Bill of Sale.


