

MANUFACTURING AGREEMENT SUPPLEMENT NO. 3

INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION


dated as of June 1, 1980, between PULLMAN INCORPORATED (Pullman Standard Division) (hereinafter called the Manufacturer) and RAILBOX COMPANY (hereinafter called the Company).

The parties hereto have heretofore entered into a Manufacturing Agreement dated as of June 15, 1979, which was filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to 49 U.S.C. § 11303 (a) of the Interstate Commerce Act on June 15, 1980, at 4:00 p.m., recordation number 10512, which provides for the execution and delivery from time to time of supplements thereto each substantially in the form hereof for the purpose of subjecting to said Manufacturing Agreement additional units of new, standard gauge railroad equipment.

The units of railroad equipment described in Item 1 of Annex A hereto, are hereby subjected to said Manufacturing Agreement. The information set forth in Annex A hereto in respect of such units of railroad equipment, and set forth in Items 2, 3, and 4 of said Annex A, is hereby incorporated into Annex A to the Manufacturing Agreement as though originally set forth therein; provided, however, that such information shall apply and refer only to the units of railroad equipment described in Annex A hereto.


