

For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged, Lincoln National Bank and Trust Company of Fort Wayne ("Lincoln National") hereby releases and discharges any and all of its rights, title, interests, liens or other claims, of every kind and nature whatsoever, now and hereafter acquired and attached to, contained in or arising under the Reassignment of Sublease and Agreement dated as of October 31, 1975 by and between Continental Illinois National Bank and Trust Company of Chicago, as trustee, and Lincoln National, as agent ("Reassignment of Sublease and Agreement"). The Reassignment of Sublease and Agreement was filed and recorded on January 6, 1976 at 12:35 p.m. with the Interstate Commerce Commission and bears the Recordation Number 8170-F. This release shall be an unconditional release and discharge, fully enforceable against Lincoln National in accordance with its terms.

Lincoln National covenants and agrees that it will execute and deliver any additional documents necessary to confirm the release and discharge of the rights, title and interests of Lincoln National under the Reassignment and Sublease and Agreement as contemplated herein.
