WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Owners by a Construction Contract (the "Construction Contract") granted a security interest to the Contractor in certain Hulks, as defined in said Construction Contract, as security for the payment of the Base Price as adjusted for escalation for the railroad cars, as defined in the Construction Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Construction Contract has been filed with and recorded by the Interstate Commerce Commission in accordance with 49 U.S.C., 11303; and

WHEREAS, the Base Price as adjusted for escalation and all other sums secured by the Construction Contract have been paid in full;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the sum of \$1.00 and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and in pursuance of the terms and provisions of the Construction Contract, the Contractor hereby releases and relinquishes any and all right, title, claim or demand of the Contractor in and to the Hulks and in the rebuilt railroad cars described below arising by, through or under the Construction Contract.


