INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

In accordance with the provisions of Section 11303 of the Interstate Commerce Act and the Rules and Regulations of the Interstate Commerce Commission thereunder, there is submitted herewith for filing and recordation a Bill of Sale and Assignment and a Release of Equipment Trust Agreement of the railroad cars used or intended for use in connection with interstate commerce as follows:

RELEASE OF EQUIPMENT TRUST EQUIPMENT

AGREEMENT dated as of July 31, 1986, by and between FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF FORT WORTH, a Texas banking corporation, as Trustee ("First National Bank of Fort Worth"), and RICHMOND LEASING COMPANY, a Delaware corporation ("RLC").

W I T N E S S E T H

WHEREAS, First National Bank of Fort Worth and RLC are parties to the Equipment Trust Agreement dated as of January 30, 1976, as supplemented ("Equipment Trust Agreement"), by and between First National Bank of Fort Worth (Trustee) and RLC (as successor to Marathon Leasing Company), filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission on February 5, 1976, under Recordation No. 8207;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Equipment Trust Agreement, RLC has made all payments due or to become due thereunder and the lease of the Trust Equipment (as defined therein) by First National Bank of Fort Worth to RLC is to terminate;

WHEREAS, by separate instrument First National Bank of Fort Worth has conveyed to RLC all right, title and interest of First National Bank of Fort Worth in and to the Trust Equipment;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and pursuant to the provisions of the Equipment Trust Agreement, First National Bank of Fort Worth; hereby confirms, agrees and acknowledges that the lease of the Trust Equipment by First National Bank of Fort Worth to RLC pursuant to the Equipment Trust Agreement is terminated and First National Bank of Fort Worth hereby releases any security interest, lien, claim, right, title or interest which it has or may have in and to the Trust Equipment (as defined in the Equipment Trust Agreement), including the Trust Equipment described in Exhibit "A" hereto, and in any sublease or Existing Lease (as defined in the Equipment Trust Agreement) on the Trust Equipment.
