This Release and Discharge dated November 9, 1979 from ITEL CORPORATION RAIL DIVISION (the "Contractor"), with an office at Two Embarcadero Center, San Francisco, California, 94111, to KOSSIS-MAGRISH COMPANY (the "Owner"), whose address is at P. O. Box 1196, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, 15230.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Owner by a Construction Contract (the "Construction Contract") granted a security interest to the Contractor in certain Hulks, as defined in said Construction Contract, as security for the payment of the Base Price as adjusted for escalation for the railroad cars, as defined in the Construction Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Construction Contract has been filed with and recorded by the Interstate Commerce Commission in accordance with 49 U.S.C., 11303; and

WHEREAS, the Base Price as adjusted for escalation and all other sums secured by the Construction Contract have been paid in full;
