RELEASE OF SECURITY AGREEMENT

Release dated as of December 1, 1979 from EFH LEASING CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation ("EFH"), having its principal office at One West Main Street, Rochester, New York to DBT FINANCIAL SERVICES CORPORATION ("Company"), having its principal office at 211 West Fort Street, Detroit, Michigan.

W I T N E S S E T H:

The Company and EFH have executed and delivered a certain Security Agreement dated as of September 17, 1979 (which agreement, together with any amendments which have been made thereto, is hereinafter called the "Security Agreement") as security for certain loans made to the Company and EFH as joint obligors.

The Security Agreement was filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to 49 USC 11303 on September 19, 1979 and assigned Recordation No. 10833.

The Company has assigned and granted to EFH under the Security Agreement a security interest in and to (i) certain equipment described in Schedule A annexed hereto (the "Equipment") and (ii) a certain Lease described in said Schedule A (the "Lease").

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, EFH hereby agrees as follows:

EFH hereby releases all liens, security interest and other rights, titles and interests it possesses or holds in said Equipment and Lease.
