TERMINATION AGREEMENT AND RELEASE

WHEREAS, Wilmington Trust Company ("WTC") and the Maryland and Pennsylvania Railroad Company ("MPA") are parties to a Security Agreement (the "Security Agreement") dated as of December 19, 1986, covering four hundred fifty (450) boxcars bearing road numbers listed on Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereto (the "Cars");

WHEREAS, the Security Agreement was filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission on February 20, 1987 and bears Recordation No. 15172; and

WHEREAS, WTC and MPA desire to terminate the Security Agreement and WTC desires to release the lien and security interest created pursuant to the Security Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein and for other valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree:

1. Termination. The Security Agreement is terminated and the Cars are released from the liens, assignment and security interest created thereunder.

2. Filing. The parties consent to the filing of this Termination and Release and any other necessary documents with the Interstate Commerce Commission (and, if necessary, with any other regulatory or governmental entity) to effect a release of this lien of record existing against the Cars.

3. Counterparts. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts and by different parties hereto in

separate counterparts, each of which when so executed shall be deemed to be an original and all of which when taken together shall constitute one and the same agreement.
