MANUFACTURING AGREEMENT SUPPLEMENT #6, INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION
1988, between PULLMAN STANDARD MANUFACTURING, TRINITY INDUSTRIES,
INC. (the "Manufacturer") and TRAILER TRAIN COMPANY (the
"Company").

The parties hereto have heretofore entered into a
Manufacturing Agreement dated as of May 13, 1987, which provides




