Memorandum of a Lease Agreement, No. 082687, made and entered into as of August 26, 1987, by and between TRANSPORTATION CORPORATION OF AMERICA, AN Illinois corporation, ("Lessor") and PLUM CREEK TIMBER COMPANY, INC., a Delaware corporation, ("Lessee").

W I T N E S S E T H:




