RAILCAR DEED

For good and valuable consideration, which is acknowledged, and pursuant to Section 8 of the Railroad Equipment Lease dated February 1, 1960 ("the Lease"), between Rental Transportation, Inc., as Lessor and Cities Service Oil Company, as Lessee; Major Enterprises, Inc., a Delaware corporation, as successor in interest to Rental Transportation, Inc.:

1. Transfers and conveys to Cities Service Company any and all interest that Major Enterprises, Inc., has or may have had in the following railroad tank cars under the provisions of the Lease, said railroad tank cars being described and identified as:

5 tank cars with an individual capacity of 30,300 gallons, Class ICC 112-A-400-W, initialed EORX and numbered 30000 through 30004 inclusive, as described in Supplement 5 to the Lease dated November 11, 1960 (said railroad tank cars being hereinafter referred to as the "Railcars");

2. Represents and warrants that all obligations and amounts owed by any party under the Lease concerning the Railcars have been paid and discharged and that the Railcars are no longer covered by the Lease;

3. Represents and warrants that the Railcars are not subject to any lien, claim, security interest or encumbrance of any kind;

4. Confirms that Cities Service Company, as successor in interest to Cities Service Oil Company, has good and marketable title to the Railcars; and

5. Agrees to execute, deliver and file any further instruments which may be requested by Cities Service Company in order to implement, confirm or support the transfer of title in these railroad cars to Cities Service Company and to secure for it their full use, enjoyment and utility.

Cities Service Company agrees to reimburse Major Enterprises, Inc., for its reasonable expenses incurred in the performance of Cities Service Company's requests under item (5) above.

This instrument is dated as of October 1, 1981, which is its effective date, and has been executed by the authorized representatives of both Major Enterprises, Inc., and Cities Service Company.
