RIDER TO NACC LEASE

RIDER NUMBER 8, dated as of March 20, 1980 to the LEASE OF RAILROAD EQUIPMENT, dated as of November 2, 1979 (the "Lease"), between NORTH AMERICAN CAR CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation (the "Lessee"), and GENERAL ELECTRIC CREDIT AND LEASING CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation (the "Lessor").

Pursuant to Section 2 of the Lease, the units of railroad equipment described in Schedule A attached hereto (the "cars"), are hereby leased by the Lessor to the Lessee subject to the terms and conditions of the Lease.

The Lessee agrees to sublease the cars to Hooker Chemical and Plastics Corp., Ruco Division (the "Sublease") pursuant to a sublease dated July 9, 1979 (the "Sublease").

The annual rent for the cars for each year of the term shall be the amount indicated below:

payable as provided in Section 4 of the Lease.

The cars shall be leased to the Lessee for a period commencing on the date of delivery thereof to Sublessee, and shall continue for a period ending twelve (12) years from the first day of the month following the average date of delivery of such cars, except as provided in Section 5 of the Lease.

The Lessee warrants and represents that the representations and warranties of the Lessee in the Lease are true and correct on and as of the date hereof as though made on and as of this date.
