Dear Ms. Lee:

On January 13, 1983, pursuant to Section 11303 of Title 49 of the U.S. Code, there was filed with the Commission for recordation one Security Agreement, dated December 9, 1982, between Lincoln First Bank, N.A. ("Lincoln"), as secured party - mortgagee and Canton Development Company, Inc. ("Canton"), as debtor - mortgagor (collectively, the "Agreement"). The Agreement was assigned recordation number 13906.

This is to inform the Commission that the underlying debt secured by the Agreement has been paid by Canton and that the Agreement is no longer in effect.

In light of this development, Lincoln hereby requests that record of the Agreement be eliminated from the recordation files of the Commission.

Please advise as to whether this letter is sufficient to accomplish the deletion or whether further action to this end is required of either Lincoln or Canton, or both.
