Dated as of October 1, 1971

SUPPLEMENTAL INDENTURE, dated as of October 1, 1971, made and entered into by and between GULF POWER COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Maine (hereinafter commonly referred to as the "Company") and THE CHASE MANHATTAN BANK (National Association), a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the United States of America, with its principal office in the Borough of Manhattan, The City of New York, formerly The Chase Manhattan Bank, successor by merger to The Chase National Bank of the City of New York, as trustee (hereinafter commonly referred to as the "Trustee"), and THE CITIZENS & PEOPLES NATIONAL BANK OF PENSACOLA, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the United States of America, with its principal office in the City of Pensacola, Florida, as trustee (hereinafter commonly referred to as the "Co-Trustee"), the Trustee and the Co-Trustee being hereinafter commonly referred to as the "Trustees", as Trustees under the Indenture dated as of September 1, 1941 between the Company and The Chase National Bank of the City of New York and The Citizens & Peoples National Bank of Pensacola, as Trustees, securing bonds issued and to be issued as provided therein (hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "Indenture"),

WHEREAS the Company and the Trustees have executed and delivered the Indenture for the purpose of securing an issue of bonds of the 1971 Series described therein and such additional bonds as may from time to time be issued under and in accordance with the terms of the Indenture, the aggregate principal amount of bonds to be secured thereby being not limited, and the Indenture fully describes and sets forth the property conveyed thereby and is of record in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of each county in the State of Florida in which this Supplemental Indenture is to be recorded and is on file at the principal offices of the Trustees, above referred to; and

WHEREAS the Company and the Trustees have executed and delivered various supplemental indentures for the purpose, among others, of further securing said bonds and of setting forth the terms and provisions relating to the bonds of other series described therein, which

supplemental indentures describe and set forth additional property conveyed thereby and are also of record in the Offices of the Clerks of the Circuit Courts of some or all of the Counties in the State of Florida in which this Supplemental Indenture is to be recorded and are on file at the principal offices of the Trustees, above referred to; and

WHEREAS the Indenture provides for the issuance of bonds thereunder in one or more series and the Company, by appropriate corporate action in conformity with the terms of the Indenture, has duly determined to create a series of bonds under the Indenture to be designated as "7½% Series due 2001" (hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "Fourteenth Series"), each of which bonds shall also bear the descriptive title "First Mortgage Bond", the bonds of such series to bear interest at the annual rate designated in the title thereof and to mature October 1, 2001; and

WHEREAS each of the bonds of the Fourteenth Series is to be substantially in the following form, to-wit:

Gulf Power Company, a Maine corporation (hereinafter called the "Company"), for value received, hereby promises to pay to or registered assigns, the principal sum of Dollars on October 1, 2001, and to pay to the registered holder hereof interest on said sum from the latest semi-annual interest payment date to which interest has been paid on the bonds of this series preceding the date hereof, unless the date hereof be an interest payment date to which interest is being paid, in which case from the date hereof, or unless the date hereof is prior to April 1, 1972, in which case from

October 1, 1971 (or, if this bond is dated between the record date for any interest payment date and such interest payment date, then from such interest payment date, provided, however, that if the Company shall default in payment of the interest due on such interest payment date, then from the next preceding semi-annual interest payment date to which interest has been paid on the bonds of this series, or if such interest payment date is April 1, 1972, from October 1, 1971), at the rate per annum, until the principal hereof shall have become due and payable, specified in the title of this bond, payable on April 1 and October 1 in each year.

The provisions of this bond are continued on the reverse hereof and such continued provisions shall for all purposes have the same effect as though fully set forth at this place.

This bond shall not be valid or become obligatory for any purpose unless and until it shall have been authenticated by the execution by the Trustee or its successor in trust under the Indenture of the certificate endorsed hereon.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, Gulf Power Company has caused this bond to be executed in its name by its President or one of its Vice-Presidents by his signature or a facsimile thereof, and its corporate seal or a facsimile thereof to be affixed hereto or imprinted hereon and attested by its Secretary or one of its Assistant Secretaries by his signature or a facsimile thereof.

The interest payable on any April 1 or October 1 will, subject to certain exceptions provided in the Indenture hereinafter mentioned, be paid to the person in whose name this bond is registered at the close of business on the record date, which shall be the March 15 or September 15, as the case may be, next preceding such interest payment date, or, if such March 15 or September 15 shall be a legal holiday or a day on which banking institutions in the Borough of Manhattan, The City of New York, are authorized to close, the next preceding day which shall not be a legal holiday or a day on which such institutions are so authorized to close. The principal of and the premium, if any, and interest on this bond shall be payable at the office or agency of the Company in the Borough of Manhattan, The City of New York, designated for that purpose, in any coin or currency of the United States of America which at the time of payment is legal tender for public and private debts.

This bond is one of the bonds issued and to be issued from time to time under and in accordance with and all secured by an indenture of mortgage or deed of trust dated as of September 1, 1941, between the Company and The Chase National Bank of the City of New York to

which The Chase Manhattan Bank (now The Chase Manhattan Bank (National Association)) is successor by merger (hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "Trustee"), and The Citizens & Peoples National Bank of Pensacola, as Trustees, and indentures supplemental thereto, to which indenture and indentures supplemental thereto (hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Indenture") reference is hereby made for a description of the property mortgaged and pledged, the nature and extent of the security and the rights, duties and immunities thereunder of the Trustees and the rights of the holders of said bonds and of the Trustees and of the Company in respect of such security, and the limitations on such rights. By the terms of the Indenture the bonds to be secured thereby are issuable in series which may vary as to date, amount, date of maturity, rate of interest and in other respects as in the Indenture provided.

Upon notice given by mailing the same, by first class mail postage prepaid, not less than thirty nor more than forty-five days prior to the date fixed for redemption to each registered holder of a bond to be redeemed (in whole or in part) at the last address of such holder appearing on the registry books, any or all of the bonds of this series may be redeemed by the Company, at its option, or by operation of various provisions of the Indenture, at any time and from time to time by the payment of the principal amount thereof and accrued interest thereon to the date fixed for redemption, together (a), if redeemed otherwise than by the operation of the sinking or improvement fund or the maintenance and/or replacement provisions of the Indenture and otherwise than by the use of proceeds of released property, as more fully set forth in the Indenture, with a premium equal to a percentage of the principal amount thereof determined as set forth in the tabulation below under the heading "Regular Redemption Premium", provided, however, that none of the bonds of this series shall be so redeemed prior to October 1, 1976 if such redemption is for the purpose or in anticipation of refunding such bond through the use, directly or indirectly, of funds borrowed by the Company at an effective interest cost to the Company (computed in accordance with generally accepted financial practice) of less than 7.58% per annum, and (b), if redeemed by the operation of the sinking or improvement fund or the maintenance and/or replacement provisions of the Indenture or by the use of proceeds of released property, as more fully set forth in the Indenture, without premium:

and without premium if redeemed on or after October 1, 2000.

In case of certain defaults as specified in the Indenture, the principal of this bond may be declared or may become due and payable on the conditions, at the time, in the manner and with the effect provided in the Indenture.

No recourse shall be had for the payment of the principal of or premium, if any, or interest on this bond, or for any claim based hereon, or otherwise in respect hereof or of the Indenture, to or against any incorporator, stockholder, director or officer, past, present or future, as such, of the Company, or of any predecessor or successor company, either directly or through the Company, or such predecessor or successor company, under any constitution or statute or rule of law, or by the enforcement of any assessment or penalty, or otherwise, all such liability of incorporators, stockholders, directors and officers, as such, being waived and released by the holder and owner hereof by the acceptance of this bond and being likewise waived and released by the terms of the Indenture.

Every bond of this series shall be dated as of the date of authentication.

This bond is transferable by the registered owner hereof, in person or by attorney duly authorized, at the principal office of the Trustee, in the Borough of Manhattan, The City of New York, but only in the manner prescribed in the Indenture, upon the surrender and cancellation of

this bond and the payment of charges for transfer, and upon any such transfer a new bond or bonds of the same series and maturity date and for the same aggregate principal amount, in authorized denominations, will be issued to the transferee in exchange herefor. The Company and the Trustees may deem and treat the person in whose name this bond is registered as the absolute owner for the purpose of receiving payment and for all other purposes. Bonds of this series shall be exchangeable for bonds of other authorized denominations having the same aggregate principal amount, in the manner and upon the conditions prescribed in the Indenture. However, notwithstanding the provisions of the Indenture, no charge shall be made upon any transfer or exchange of bonds of this series other than for any tax or taxes or other governmental charge required to be paid by the Company.

AND WHEREAS all acts and things necessary to make the bonds, when authenticated by the Trustee and issued as in the Indenture, as heretofore supplemented and amended, and this Supplemental Indenture, provided, the valid, binding and legal obligations of the Company, and to constitute the Indenture, as heretofore supplemented and amended, and this Supplemental Indenture valid, binding and legal instruments for the security thereof, have been done and performed, and the creation, execution and delivery of the Indenture, as heretofore supplemented and amended, and this Supplemental Indenture and the creation, execution and issue of bonds subject to the terms hereof and of the Indenture, have in all respects been duly authorized;

Now, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, and of the acceptance and purchase by the holders thereof of the bonds issued and to be issued under the Indenture, and of the sum of One Dollar duly paid by the Trustees to the Company, and of other good and valuable considerations, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and for the purpose of securing the due and punctual payment of the principal of and premium, if any, and interest on the bonds now outstanding under the Indenture, or the Indenture as supplemented and amended, and the \$21,000,000 principal amount of bonds of the Fourteenth Series proposed to be initially issued and all other bonds which shall be issued under the Indenture, or the Indenture as supplemented and amended,

and for the purpose of securing the faithful performance and observance of all covenants and conditions therein and in any indenture supplemental thereto set forth, the Company has given, granted, bargained, sold, transferred, assigned, hypothecated, pledged, mortgaged, warranted, aliened and conveyed and by these presents does give, grant, bargain, sell, transfer, assign, hypothecate, pledge, mortgage, warrant, alien and convey unto The Chase Manhattan Bank (National Association) and The Citizens & Peoples National Bank of Pensacola, as Trustees, as provided in the Indenture, and their successor or successors in the trust thereby and hereby created and to their assigns forever, all the right, title and interest of the Company in and to the following described property located in the State of Florida, together (subject to the provisions of Article X of the Indenture) with the tolls, rents, revenues, issues, earnings, income, products and profits thereof:

I

STEAM GENERATING PLANTS

1. All additions to Crist Steam Plant, formerly designated as Pensacola Steam Plant, located on Governor's Bayou and Thompson's Bayou near Pensacola, Florida in Escambia County, not heretofore described in the Indenture or any supplement thereto and not heretofore released from the lien of the Indenture.

2. All additions to Scholz Steam Plant, formerly designated as River Junction Steam Plant, located on the west bank of the Apalachicola River in Jackson County near Chattahoochee, Florida, not heretofore described in the Indenture or any supplement thereto and not heretofore released from the lien of the Indenture.

3. All additions to Lansing Smith Steam Plant located on Alligator Bayou and North Bay near Panama City, Florida situated in Bay County, not heretofore described in the Indenture or any supplement thereto and not heretofore released from the lien of the Indenture.

II

ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION LINES

All the electric transmission lines of the Company acquired or constructed by it and not heretofore described in the Indenture or any supplement thereto and not heretofore released from the lien of the Indenture, including towers, poles, pole lines, wires, switch racks, switchboards, insulators and other appliances and equipment, and all other property, real or personal, forming a part of or appertaining to or used, occupied or enjoyed in connection with such transmission lines or any of them, or adjacent thereto, and all service lines extending therefrom; together with all real property, rights of way, easements, permits, privileges, franchises and rights for or relating to the construction, maintenance or operation thereof, through, over, under or upon any private property or any public streets or highways within as well as without the corporate limits of any municipal corporation or other governmental subdivision, including property in the State of Florida described as:

1. Brentwood to Goulding Transmission Line Additions not heretofore described in the Indenture or any supplement thereto located in Escambia County.

Together with land in Escambia County upon which a portion of said transmission line is located described as:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of Block 38, North Pensacola Unit No. 4, according to Plat Book 2, Page 57 of the Records of Escambia County, Florida, thence South $80^{\circ} 19'$ West 170 feet; thence North $19^{\circ} 31'$ West 50 feet to point of beginning; thence continue North $19^{\circ} 31'$ West 50 feet, thence North $70^{\circ} 29'$ East 88.37 feet, thence South $9^{\circ} 41'$ East 56.7 feet; thence South $75^{\circ} 24'$ West 79.19 feet to point of beginning, Section 4, Township 2 South, Range 30 West.

Less that part lying northerly of and within 150 feet of the survey line of a State Road, Section 48519-2601, said survey line being described as follows: Begin on the northerly extension of the easterly line of Block 39, North Pensacola Unit No. 4, as per plat recorded in Plat Book 2, Page 57 of the public records of

Escambia County, Florida, at a point 50.0 feet northerly of the Northeast corner of said Block 39; thence run South $80^{\circ} 18' 10''$ West 606.35 feet to the end of survey line herein described: containing 0.09 of an acre (3,808 square feet), more or less, as described in instrument recorded in Official Record Book 432 at Page 548 of the Public Records of Escambia County, Florida.

2. The Lullwater Transmission Tap Line now under construction extending from the Company's Lullwater Substation, also under construction, 0.75 mile to tap the Company's Laguna Beach to Long Beach Transmission Line situated in Bay County together with land in Bay County upon which a portion of said transmission line is to be located, described as:

That part of the West one-half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section seventeen (17) and the South one-half ($S\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of section eight (8), all lying in Township three (3) South, Range sixteen (16) West, Bay County, Florida, lying within a continuous strip of land one hundred fifty (150) feet in width, being seventy-five (75) feet on each side of a centerline and a continuation thereof, said centerline to begin at a point one hundred four and twenty-five one-hundredths (104.25) feet north and seventy-five (75) feet east of the Southwest corner of the said West one-half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) of said Section seventeen (17) for the point of beginning of said centerline; thence from said point of beginning, run North 00 degrees 05 minutes West a distance of one thousand two hundred ninety-eight and two-tenths (1,298.2) feet to an angle point, to be hereinafter referred to as Point "A"; thence from said angle point run North 29 degrees 12 minutes East a distance of two thousand four hundred eighty-one and eight-tenths (2,481.8) feet to an intersection of the Southwesterly boundary of Gulf Power Company's 100 ft. wide right-of-way for its LAGUNA BEACH-LONG BEACH transmission line as it now exists, said intersection being in the said South one-half ($S\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of said section eight (8);

ALSO:

That part of the Southwest quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) in said Section seventeen (17), and the Northeast quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section eighteen

(18), all in Township three (3) South, Range sixteen (16) West, Bay County, Florida, lying within a continuous strip of land ten (10) feet in width, being five (5) feet on each side of a center and a continuation thereof, said centerline being described as follows:

Begin again at the aforementioned Point "A" (located and identified in the description of the first parcel hereinabove described), and from said Point "A" run North 75 degrees 21 minutes 30 seconds West a distance of one hundred twenty-five (125) feet to termination point in the Northeast quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section eighteen (18) Township three (3) South, Range sixteen (16) West, Bay County, Florida.

3. The Panama City Switching Station Loop Line, now under construction, extending 0.3 mile to tie in the Company's Scholz to Highland City Transmission Line situated in Bay County and extending 1 mile to tie in the Company's Scholz to Wewa Transmission Line also in Bay County.

Together with land in Bay County upon which a portion of said transmission line is to be located, described as:

That part of the following tracts of land, to-wit: the southeast quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section twenty-nine (29); the northeast quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$), the north half ($N\frac{1}{2}$) of the southeast quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section thirty-two (32), all lying and being in Township three (3) south, Range thirteen (13) west, Bay County, Florida, lying within a continuous strip of land being partially two hundred forty feet (240') in width and partially one hundred twenty feet (120') in width, the two hundred forty foot (240') portion being one hundred twenty feet (120') on each side of a centerline, the one hundred twenty foot (120') portion being sixty feet (60') on each side of a centerline, said centerline to begin at a point in the southeast quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section twenty-nine (29), Township three (3) south, Range thirteen (13) west, determined as follows: From the southwest corner of said Section twenty-nine (29) run North $00^{\circ}21'$ west a distance of one thousand one hundred seventy-three and four tenths feet (1,173.4') to a point, thence from said point run south $88^{\circ}58'$ east a distance of two thousand seven hundred twenty-seven and two tenths feet (2,727.2') to a point, thence from said point run North $19^{\circ}34'$ east a distance of four hundred

seventy-one and fifty-five one-hundredths feet (471.55') to a point, thence from said point run south 88°22' east a distance of four hundred thirty-eight and twelve one-hundredths feet (438.12') to the point of beginning of said centerline and the two hundred forty foot (240') width portion; thence from said point of beginning run south 01°33' west a distance of four hundred forty-two and twenty-five one-hundredths feet (442.25') to a point on the centerline of Gulf Power Company's Scholz-Highland City transmission line as it now exists, being the end of the two hundred forty foot (240') width portion and the beginning of the one hundred twenty foot (120') width portion, thence from said point continue south 01°33' west a distance of four thousand two hundred sixty-seven and eighty-five one-hundredths feet (4,267.85'), more or less, to a point on the centerline of Gulf Power Company's River Junction-Wewa Road transmission line as it now exists in the north half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) of the southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section thirty-two (32), Township three (3) south, Range thirteen (13) west, Bay County, Florida.

4. The Eglin West Gate Transmission Line, now under construction, extending 3 miles from a tap in the Company's Valparaiso to Ocean City Transmission Line to Eglin's proposed West Gate Substation.

Together with permit upon which a portion of said transmission line is located described as:

Permit from the Government of the United States for an aerial transmission line across Eglin Air Force Base Military Reservation dated April 5, 1971.

III

DISTRIBUTION SYSTEMS

All the electric distribution systems of the Company acquired or constructed by it and not heretofore described in the Indenture or any supplement thereto and not heretofore released from the lien of the Indenture, including substations, transformers, switchboards, towers, poles, wires, insulators, subways, trenches, conduits, manholes, cables,

meters and other appliances and equipment and all other property, real or personal, forming a part of or appertaining to or used, occupied or enjoyed in connection with such distribution systems or any of them, or adjacent thereto; together with all real property, rights of way, easements, permits, privileges, franchises, and rights for or relating to the construction, maintenance or operation thereof, through, over, under or upon any private property or any public streets or highways within as well as without the corporate limits of any municipal corporation or other governmental subdivision, property in the State of Florida described as:

(a) Permit from the Government of the United States for underground power lines situated at Naval Air Station, Saufley Field, Pensacola, Florida, in Escambia County dated December 18, 1970.

(b) Permit from the Government of the United States for relocation of aerial transmission line across Davenport Bayou in Escambia County, Florida, dated October 12, 1970.

IV

SUBSTATIONS

All of the substations of the Company for transforming or distributing or otherwise regulating electric current at any of its plants and elsewhere acquired or constructed by it and not heretofore described in the Indenture or any supplement thereto and not heretofore released from the lien of the Indenture, together with all buildings, transformers, wires, insulators and other appliances and equipment, and all other property, real or personal, forming a part of or appertaining to or used, occupied or enjoyed in connection with any of such substations or adjacent thereto, property in the State of Florida described as:

1. Lullwater Substation, now under construction, situated in Bay County, Florida, located on land described as:

Begin at the intersection of the West Line of Section 17, Township 3 South, Range 16 West, and the Northerly R/W Line of S. R. 30-A, (U.S. 98 Alt.), said point being also the SE Corner of Gulf Highlands, as per plat thereof recorded in Plat Book 8, page 79, of the Public

Records of Bay County, Florida; thence $N00^{\circ}05'W$, along said West Line of Section 17, 400 feet; thence $N89^{\circ}55'E$, 400 feet; thence $S00^{\circ}05'E$, 533.8 feet to said North R/W Line of S.R. 30-A (U.S. 98 Alt.); thence $N71^{\circ}35'18'' W$ along said North R/W Line, 421.78 feet to the Point of Beginning. Containing 4.3 acres more or less.

2. Wright Substation, now under construction, situated in Okaloosa County, Florida, located on land described as:

Begin at the Southwest Corner of Lot 9, Block 3, Fairview Heights Subdivision, as recorded in Plat Book 2, Page 127 of the Public Records of Okaloosa County, Florida, and run South along West line of said Block 3 800 feet to the Southwest Corner of Lot 1, Block 3 of the said Fairview Heights Subdivision and the North right-of-way line of a county road (Circle Drive); thence $S 89^{\circ}24'W$, along said right-of-way 619.37 feet; thence $N 01^{\circ}38'W$ 814.25 feet; thence $S 89^{\circ}20'E$ 642.84 feet to the point of beginning; said tract being in Section 4, Township 2 South, Range 24 West, Okaloosa County, Florida.

3. Alford Substation situated in Jackson County, Florida, located on land described as:

Commence at the South West Corner of the South East Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the South West Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 33, Township 4 North, Range 11 West, Jackson County, Florida, thence North $01^{\circ}07'06''$ East (Basic of bearing is SRD Datum) along the West line of said South East ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the South West Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) 199.42' thence South $87^{\circ}29'16''$ East 17.35 feet to Point of Beginning; thence North $02^{\circ}30'44''$ East 250 feet to South right-of-way line of SR S-276, said right-of-way line being a curve concave to the South and having a radius of 5,679.67 feet; thence East along said curve 208.29 feet; thence South $02^{\circ}30'44''$ West 308.15 feet; thence North $87^{\circ}29'16''$ West 200 feet to the Point of Beginning, containing 1.284 acres, more or less.

4. Panama City Switching Station, now under construction, situated in Bay County, Florida, located on land described as:

Commencing at the southwest corner of Section twenty-nine (29), Township three (3) south, Range thirteen (13) west; thence north

00°21' west (basis of bearing is centerline bearing of north 88°58' west of Scholz-Highland City Power Line), one thousand one hundred seventy-three and four tenths feet (1,173.4') to the centerline of said Power Line; thence south 88°58' east, along said centerline, two thousand seven hundred twenty-seven and two tenths feet (2,727.2'); thence north 19°34' east, four hundred seventy-one and fifty-five one-hundredths feet (471.55'), to a point on the east side of a graded road, said point being the Point of Beginning, and said point being also described as being south 88°22' east, eight hundred twelve and six tenths feet (812.6') from the Southeast Corner (as marked by a St. Joe Paper Company Monument) of Lot eighty-six (86), of said Section twenty-nine (29); thence north 18°17'16" east, along the east side of said graded road, six hundred eighty-eight and eighty-nine one hundredths feet (688.89'); thence south 88°22' east, nine hundred ninety-one feet (991'); thence south 01°17'20" west, six hundred sixty feet (660'); thence north 88°22' west, one thousand one hundred ninety-two and four tenths feet (1,192.4') to the Point of Beginning, containing sixteen and five tenths (16.5) acres, more or less.

V

OTHER REAL PROPERTY

All other real property of the Company and all interests therein of every nature and description and wherever located acquired by it and not heretofore described in the Indenture or any supplement thereto and not heretofore released from the lien of the Indenture. Including property in the State of Florida described as:

1. Land situate, lying and being in the County of Escambia, State of Florida, to-wit:

Lots Six (6) to Ten (10) both inclusive in Block One Hundred Forty-three (143) West King Tract in the City of Pensacola, Escambia County, Florida, according to map of said City copyrighted by Thomas C. Watson in 1906, LESS the east fifty feet (50') of said lots.

TOGETHER WITH all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances belonging or in any wise appertaining to the premises,

property, franchises and rights, or any thereof, referred to in the foregoing granting clauses, with the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders and (subject to the provisions of Article X of the Indenture) the tolls, rents, revenues, issues, earnings, income, products and profits thereof, and all the estate, right, title and interest and claim whatsoever, at law as well as in equity, which the Company now has or may hereafter acquire in and to the aforesaid premises, property, franchises and rights and every part and parcel thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all said premises, property, franchises and rights hereby conveyed, assigned, pledged or mortgaged, or intended so to be, unto the Trustees, their successor or successors in trust, and their assigns forever;

BUT IN TRUST, NEVERTHELESS, with power of sale, for the equal and proportionate benefit and security of the holders of all bonds and interest coupons now or hereafter issued under the Indenture, as supplemented and amended, pursuant to the provisions thereof, and for the enforcement of the payment of said bonds and coupons when payable and the performance of and compliance with the covenants and conditions of the Indenture, as supplemented and amended, without any preference, distinction or priority as to lien or otherwise of any bond or bonds over others by reason of the difference in time of the actual issue, sale or negotiation thereof or for any other reason whatsoever, except as otherwise expressly provided in the Indenture, as supplemented and amended; and so that each and every bond now or hereafter issued thereunder shall have the same lien, and so that the principal of and premium, if any, and interest on every such bond shall, subject to the terms of the Indenture, as supplemented and amended, be equally and proportionately secured thereby and hereby, as if it had been made, executed, delivered, sold and negotiated simultaneously with the execution and delivery of the Indenture.

AND IT IS EXPRESSLY DECLARED that all bonds issued and secured thereunder and hereunder are to be issued, authenticated and delivered, and all said premises, property, franchises and rights hereby and

by the Indenture, as supplemented and amended, conveyed, assigned, pledged or mortgaged, or intended so to be (including all the right, title and interest of the Company in and to any and all premises, property, franchises and rights of every kind and description, real, personal and mixed, tangible and intangible, thereafter acquired by the Company and whether or not specifically described in the Indenture or in any indenture supplemental thereto, except any therein expressly excepted), are to be dealt with and disposed of, under, upon and subject to the terms, conditions, stipulations, covenants, agreements, trusts, uses and purposes in the Indenture, as supplemented and amended, expressed, and it is hereby agreed as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created a series of bonds designated as hereinabove set forth (said bonds being sometimes herein referred to as the "bonds of the Fourteenth Series"), and the form thereof shall be substantially as hereinbefore set forth. Bonds of the Fourteenth Series shall mature on the date specified in the form thereof hereinbefore set forth, and the definitive bonds of such series shall be issued only as registered bonds without coupons. Bonds of the Fourteenth Series shall be in such denominations as the Board of Directors shall approve, and execution and delivery thereof to the Trustee for authentication shall be conclusive evidence of such approval. The serial numbers of bonds shall be such as may be approved by any officer of the Company, the execution thereof by any such officer to be conclusive evidence of such approval.

Bonds of the Fourteenth Series, until the principal thereof shall have become due and payable, shall bear interest at the annual rate designated in the title thereof, payable semi-annually on April 1 and October 1 in each year.

The principal of and premium, if any, and the interest on the bonds of the Fourteenth Series shall be payable in any coin or currency of the United States of America which at the time of payment is legal tender for public and private debts, at the office or agency of the Company in the Borough of Manhattan, The City of New York, designated for that purpose.

Bonds of the Fourteenth Series may be transferred at the principal office of the Trustee, in the Borough of Manhattan, The City of New York. Bonds of the Fourteenth Series shall be exchangeable for other bonds of the same series, in the manner and upon the conditions prescribed in the Indenture, upon the surrender of such bonds at said principal office of the Trustee. However, notwithstanding the provisions of Section 2.05 of the Indenture, no charge shall be made upon any transfer or exchange of bonds of said series other than for any tax or taxes or other governmental charge required to be paid by the Company.

The person in whose name any bond of the Fourteenth Series is registered at the close of business on any record date (as hereinbelow defined) with respect to any interest payment date shall be entitled to receive the interest payable on such interest payment date notwithstanding the cancellation of such bond upon any transfer or exchange thereof subsequent to the record date and prior to such interest payment date, except if and to the extent the Company shall default in the payment of the interest due on such interest payment date, in which case such defaulted interest shall be paid to the person in whose name such bond (or any bond or bonds issued, directly or after intermediate transactions, upon transfer or exchange or in substitution thereof) is registered on a subsequent record date for such payment established as hereinafter provided. A subsequent record date may be established by the Company by notice mailed to the holders of bonds not less than ten days preceding such record date, which record date shall be not less than five nor more than thirty days prior to the subsequent interest payment date. The term "record date" as used in this Section with respect to any regular interest payment date shall mean the March 15 or September 15, as the case may be, next preceding such interest payment date, or, if such March 15 or September 15 shall be a legal holiday or a day on which banking institutions in the Borough of Manhattan, The City of New York, are authorized by law to close, the next preceding day which shall not be a legal holiday or a day on which such institutions are so authorized to close.

Bonds of the Fourteenth Series shall be dated as of the date of authentication and shall bear interest from the latest semi-annual interest payment date to which interest has been paid on the bonds of such series preceding the date of authentication, unless such date of authentication be an interest payment date to which interest is being paid on the bonds of such series, in which case they shall bear interest from such date of authentication, provided that bonds authenticated prior to the first interest payment date shall bear interest from a date six months prior to such date. However, so long as there is no existing default in the payment of interest on such bonds, the holder of any bond authenticated by the Trustee between the record date for any interest payment date and such interest payment date shall not be entitled to the payment of the interest due on such interest payment date and shall have no claim against the Company with respect thereto; provided, further, that, if and to the extent the Company shall default in the payment of the interest due on such interest payment date, then any such bond shall bear interest from the April 1 or October 1, as the case may be, next preceding the date of such bond, to which interest has been paid or, if the Company shall be in default with respect to the interest due on April 1, 1972, then from October 1, 1971.

Any or all of the bonds of the Fourteenth Series shall be redeemable at the option of the Company, or by operation of various provisions of the Indenture, as supplemented and amended, at any time and from time to time, prior to maturity, upon notice given by mailing the same, by first class mail postage prepaid, not less than thirty nor more than forty-five days prior to the date fixed for redemption to each registered holder of a bond to be redeemed (in whole or in part) at the last address of such holder appearing on the registry books, at the principal amount thereof and accrued interest thereon to the date fixed for redemption, together (a), if redeemed otherwise than by the operation of Section 2.12 or 7.07 of the Indenture or of Section 4 of the Supplemental Indenture dated as of October 1, 1964 or of Section 2 of this Supplemental Indenture or of the sinking or improvement fund provisions of any Supplemental Indenture other than this Supplemental Indenture and otherwise than by the use of proceeds of released property, with a regular redemption premium

equal to a percentage of the principal amount thereof determined as set forth in the tabulation appearing in the form of bond hereinbefore set forth, provided, however, that none of the bonds of the Fourteenth Series shall be so redeemed prior to October 1, 1976 if such redemption is for the purpose or in anticipation of refunding such bond through the use, directly or indirectly, of funds borrowed by the Company at an effective interest cost to the Company (computed in accordance with generally accepted financial practice) of less than the cost per annum appearing in the form of bond hereinbefore set forth, and (b), if redeemed by the operation of Section 2.12 or 7.07 of the Indenture or of Section 4 of the Supplemental Indenture dated as of October 1, 1964 or of Section 2 of this Supplemental Indenture or of the sinking or improvement fund provisions of any Supplemental Indenture other than this Supplemental Indenture or by the use of proceeds of released property, either (i) with a special redemption premium, if any, equal to a percentage of the principal amount thereof determined as set forth in the tabulation appearing in the form of bond hereinbefore set forth or (ii), if no special redemption premium is so set forth, then without premium.

SECTION 2. The Company covenants that, so long as any bonds of the Fourteenth Series shall be outstanding under the Indenture, it will, on or before June 1 in each year commencing with June 1, 1972:

(a) deposit with the Trustee subject to the provisions of this Section cash and/or bonds of any series authenticated under the Indenture then outstanding (taken at their principal amount) in an amount equal to the "improvement fund requirement" (which term, as used in this Section, shall mean for any year an amount equal to one per centum (1%) of the aggregate principal amount of bonds of the Fourteenth Series authenticated and delivered by the Trustee pursuant to the provisions of Articles IV, V and VI of the Indenture, prior to January 1 of that year, after deducting from such aggregate principal amount the principal amount of bonds of the Fourteenth Series which, prior to January 1 of that year, have been deposited with the Trustee for cancellation as the basis for the release of property or for the withdrawal of cash representing proceeds of released property or have been purchased or redeemed by the use of proceeds of released property); or,

(b) to the extent that it does not so deposit cash and/or bonds, certify to the Trustee unfunded net property additions in an amount equal to one hundred sixty-six and two-thirds per centum ($166\frac{2}{3}\%$) of the portion of the improvement fund requirement not so satisfied;

provided, however, that, so long as Section 2.12 of the Indenture shall remain in effect, compliance with the requirements of said Section 2.12 shall constitute compliance with the requirements of this Section.

The term "improvement fund certificate", as used in this Section, shall mean an accountant's certificate filed by the Company with the Trustee pursuant to this Section. Such certificate may be a separate certificate or it may be combined with an improvement fund certificate or certificates filed pursuant to the improvement fund provisions of the Indenture or of any other indenture or indentures supplemental thereto.

On or before the first day of June in each year, beginning June 1, 1972, so long as any bonds of the Fourteenth Series are outstanding under the Indenture, the Company shall (if Section 2.12 of the Indenture is no longer in effect) deliver to the Trustee an improvement fund certificate showing the improvement fund requirement for that year, the amount of cash, if any, and the principal amount of bonds authenticated under the Indenture then outstanding, if any, then to be deposited by the Company with the Trustee and, if the Company elects to satisfy the improvement fund requirement for that year in whole or in part by the certification of unfunded net property additions, the amount, if any, of unfunded net property additions to be certified. The Company shall, concurrently with the delivery to the Trustee of such certificate, deposit with the Trustee the amount of cash, if any, and the principal amount of bonds, if any, shown in such certificate.

No property additions shall be certified in any improvement fund certificate pursuant to the provisions of this Section unless there shall be delivered to the Trustee with such certificate the applicable certificates, opinion of counsel, instruments and cash, if any, required by paragraphs (3), (4), (5), (7), (9) and (10) of Section 4.05 of the Indenture, showing that the Company has unfunded net property additions equal to the amount so certified.

The Trustee shall hold any cash deposited with it under the provisions of this Section as a part of the mortgaged and pledged property until paid out as hereinafter provided. Any cash deposited with the Trustee under the provisions of this Section may, upon receipt by the Trustee of the written order of the Company signed by its President or a Vice-President, of a treasurer's certificate such as is described in paragraph (2) of Section 4.05 of the Indenture and of an opinion of counsel,

(1) be withdrawn, used or applied by the Company in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (2), (3) or (4) of Section 10.05 of the Indenture, except that any premium required to be paid to purchase or redeem bonds shall be paid out of funds held by the Trustee under this Section, and the Company shall not be required to furnish the Trustee with additional funds for such purpose or to reimburse the Trustee or the improvement fund for moneys so paid out. Interest and expenses in connection with purchases or redemptions pursuant to this Section shall be dealt with as provided in Section 9.05 of the Indenture; or

(2) be withdrawn by the Company to the extent of sixty per centum (60%) of the amount of unfunded net property additions certified to the Trustee for such purpose, but only upon receipt by the Trustee of the applicable certificates, opinion of counsel, instruments and cash, if any, required by paragraphs (3), (4), (5), (7), (9) and (10) of Section 4.05 of the Indenture, showing that the Company has unfunded net property additions equal to the amount so certified.

Bonds deposited with the Trustee pursuant to this Section, or purchased or redeemed by the use of cash deposited pursuant to this Section, shall be cancelled and shall not be thereafter made the basis for the authentication of bonds, the withdrawal, use or application of cash, or the release of property, under any of the provisions of the Indenture, or thereafter used to satisfy the requirements of this Section or of any other sinking or improvement fund provided for in the Indenture or in any indenture supplemental thereto or to satisfy an unsatisfied balance of the maintenance and replacement requirement (as defined in Section 7.07 of the Indenture) or to satisfy any replacement deficit pursuant to Section 4 of the Supplemental Indenture dated as of October 1, 1964.

To the extent that unfunded net property additions are certified to the Trustee to satisfy the improvement fund requirement for any year in whole or in part or as a basis for the withdrawal of cash deposited with the Trustee under the provisions of this Section, the amount of such unfunded net property additions shall thereafter be deducted in computing the amount of unfunded net property additions under Section 1.11 of the Indenture and in computing gross property additions under Section 7.07 of the Indenture.

SECTION 3. The Company covenants that the provisions of Section 4 of the Supplemental Indenture dated as of October 1, 1964, which are to remain in effect so long as any bonds of the Tenth Series shall be outstanding under the Indenture, shall remain in full force and effect so long as any bonds of the Fourteenth Series shall be outstanding under the Indenture.

SECTION 4. The Company covenants that, so long as any bonds of the Fourteenth Series shall be outstanding under the Indenture, it will not, after September 30, 1971, declare or pay any dividends, or make any other distributions (except (a) dividends payable or distributions made in shares of common stock of the Company and (b) dividends payable in cash in cases where, concurrently with the payment of the dividend, an amount in cash equal to the dividend is received by the Company as a capital contribution or as the proceeds of the issue and sale of shares of its common stock), on or in respect of its common stock, or purchase or otherwise acquire for a consideration any shares of its common stock, if the aggregate of such dividends, distributions and such consideration for purchase or other acquisition of shares of its common stock after September 30, 1971, shall exceed

(i) the earned surplus of the Company accumulated after September 30, 1971 (determined in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and without giving effect to charges to earned surplus on account of such dividends, distributions or acquisitions or on account of the disposition of any amounts which may then be classified by the Company on its books as amounts in excess of the original cost of utility plant or to charges or credits

to earned surplus on account of items inherent in the balance sheet at September 30, 1971), plus

(ii) the earned surplus of the Company accumulated prior to October 1, 1971 in an amount not exceeding \$9,000,000, plus

(iii) such additional amount as shall be authorized or approved, upon application by the Company, by the Securities and Exchange Commission, or by any successor commission thereto, under the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935.

For the purposes of this Section, in determining the earned surplus of the Company accumulated after September 30, 1971, there shall be deducted the dividends accruing subsequent to September 30, 1971 on preferred stock of the Company and the total amount, if any, by which the charges to income or earned surplus since September 30, 1971 as provision for depreciation of the mortgaged and pledged property (other than specially classified property) shall have been less than the sum of the amounts equal to the product of the applicable percentage (as defined in Section 4 of the Supplemental Indenture dated as of October 1, 1964) and the mathematical average of the amounts of depreciable property (as defined in said Section 4) at the opening of business on the first day and at the close of business on the last day of each calendar year (and, proportionately, of each period of months which is less than a calendar year) subsequent to September 30, 1971 included in the period for which earned surplus is being determined; provided, however, that, so long as any bonds of any series created prior to January 1, 1964 are outstanding under the Indenture, if the total amount, if any, by which the aggregate of the charges to income or earned surplus since September 30, 1971 for repairs, maintenance and provision for depreciation of the mortgaged and pledged property (other than specially classified property) shall have been less than 16% of the gross operating revenues derived by the Company subsequent to September 30, 1971 from the mortgaged and pledged property (other than specially classified property), after deduction from such revenues of the aggregate cost of electric energy, gas and steam purchased for resale, is greater than such amount, then the amount to be deducted in determining earned surplus shall be such greater amount. The term

“consideration”, as used in this Section, shall mean cash or fair value if the consideration be other than cash, and the term “provision for depreciation”, as used in this Section, shall not be deemed to include provision for the amortization of any amounts classified by the Company on its books as amounts in excess of the original cost of utility plant.

SECTION 5. Section 2.05 of the Indenture is hereby amended by adding the following sentence at the end thereof: “As to the bonds of any series established subsequent to September 30, 1971, the Company shall not be required to make transfers or exchanges of bonds of any such series for a period of fifteen (15) days next preceding any selection of bonds of the particular series to be redeemed, and the Company shall not be required to make transfers or exchanges of the principal amount of any bonds of any such series called or selected for redemption.”

SECTION 6. As supplemented and amended by this Supplemental Indenture, the Indenture, as heretofore supplemented and amended, is in all respects ratified and confirmed and the Indenture, as heretofore supplemented and amended, and this Supplemental Indenture shall be read, taken and construed as one and the same instrument.

SECTION 7. Nothing in this Supplemental Indenture contained shall, or shall be construed to, confer upon any person other than a holder of bonds issued under the Indenture, the Company and the Trustees any right or interest to avail himself of any benefit under any provision of the Indenture, as heretofore supplemented and amended, or of this Supplemental Indenture.

SECTION 8. The Trustees assume no responsibility for or in respect of the validity or sufficiency of this Supplemental Indenture or the due execution hereof by the Company or for or in respect of the recitals and statements contained herein, all of which recitals and statements are made solely by the Company.

SECTION 9. This Supplemental Indenture may be executed in several counterparts and all such counterparts executed and delivered, each as an original, shall constitute but one and the same instrument.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, said Gulf Power Company has caused this Supplemental Indenture to be executed in its corporate name by its President or one of its Vice-Presidents and its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and to be attested by its Secretary or one of its Assistant Secretaries, and said The Chase Manhattan Bank (National Association) has caused this Supplemental Indenture to be executed in its corporate name and its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed by one of its Vice-Presidents and its corporate seal to be attested by one of its Assistant Secretaries, and The Citizens & Peoples National Bank of Pensacola has caused this Supplemental Indenture to be executed in its corporate name by its President or one of its Vice-Presidents

or one of its Trust Officers and its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and to be attested by its Cashier or one of its Assistant Cashiers, in several counterparts, all as of the day and year first above written.
