

FILING INSTRUCTIONS

55-9-401. Place of filing; erroneous filing; removal of collateral.

(1) The proper place to file in order to perfect a security interest is as follows:

(a) in the office of the county clerk in the county of the debtor's residence or, if the debtor does not reside in this state and the collateral is goods, then in the office of the county clerk in the county where the goods are kept, and in addition, when the collateral is crops, in the office of the county clerk in the county where the land on which the crops are growing or to be grown is located;

(b) when the collateral is goods which at the time of [a] security interest attaches are or are to become fixtures, then with the real estate records in the office where a mortgage on the real estate concerned would be filed or recorded;

(c) in all other cases, in the office of the secretary of state;

(d) for the purpose of this section:

(i) a corporation or incorporated association organized under the laws of this state shall be deemed to reside in the county where its registered or principal office or place of business is located as set forth in its articles or certificate of incorporation or agreement;

(ii) an unincorporated association organized under the laws of this state shall be deemed to reside in the county where its statement of organization is filed;

(iii) a partnership shall be deemed to reside in the county where its principal place of business in this state is located;

(iv) a corporation organized outside of this state and authorized to transact business in this state shall be deemed to reside in the county where its principal office in this state is located as set forth in documents filed with the state corporation commission; and

(v) all other nonindividual debtors shall be deemed nonresidents of New Mexico.




