WHEREAS, pursuant to that certain Security Agreement - Chattel Mortgage dated September 23, 1980, and filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission ("ICC") on October 3, 1980, under Recordation No. 12266, and that certain Security Agreement - Accounts, Contract Rights and General Intangibles dated September 23, 1980, and filed with the ICC on October 3, 1980, under Recordation No. 12266-A (collectively called the "Security Agreements"), LAMCO, INC., a Texas corporation ("Lamco") granted and conveyed to CAPITAL BANK, NATIONAL ASSOCIATION ("Capital Bank") a security interest in and to the following property (the "Property"), to secure payment of the note or notes described in said Security Agreements:

Ten (10) 23,500 gallon general purpose railroad tank cars, type DOT 111A100W3, registered LAMX 23580, LAMX 23581, LAMX 23582, LAMX 23583, LAMX 23584, LAMX 23602, LAMX 23607, LAMX 23613, LAMX 23623 and 23624.

WHEREAS, Capital Bank has been satisfied in full with regard to the note or notes described in the Security Agreements by payment from COMMERCIAL BANCSHARES, INC.; and


WHEREAS, COMMERCIAL BANCSHARES, INC. has requested Capital Bank to assign its interest in the Security Agreements and the Property to the said COMMERCIAL BANCSHARES, INC.;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the payment by COMMERCIAL BANCSHARES, INC. of the theretofore unpaid principal balance and accrued interest on the note or notes secured by the Security Agreements, Capital Bank does hereby GRANT, ASSIGN, and CONVEY to COMMERCIAL BANCSHARES, INC., having its principal offices at 3100 Richmond Avenue, Suite 405, Houston, Texas, all its rights, title and interest in the Security Agreements and the Property, as described therein and further agrees that COMMERCIAL BANCSHARES, INC.

shall be fully subrogated to the interest of Capital Bank in and to the Property and shall succeed to all the rights and remedies of Capital Bank with regards to the Property.


