SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT DATED AS OF AUGUST 1, 1982
TO EQUIPMENT TRUST AGREEMENT DATED AS OF DECEMBER 1, 1974

BY AND BETWEEN

CHEMICAL BANK , TRUSTEE

AND

GATX CORPORATION

(FORMERLY KNOWN AS GENERAL AMERICAN TRANSPORTATION CORPORATION)

Supplemental Agreement dated as of August 1, 1982
by and between Chemical Bank, a New York Corporation, as Trustee,
and GATX Corporation, a New York corporation formerly known as
General American Transportation Corporation.

WHEREAS, the parties hereto entered into an Equipment
Trust Agreement dated as of December 1, 1974 (the "Agreement")
creating General American Transportation Corporation Equipment
Trust, Series 72, which Agreement was filed and recorded with
the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to Section 20c of
the Interstate Commerce Act on December 2, 1974, Recordation
No. 7731; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto wish to amend Schedule A
to the Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree that Schedule A
to the Agreement is hereby amended by:

- (a) deleting therefrom the units of Trust Equipment
described in Schedule I attached hereto, and
- (b) substituting therefor the units of Equipment described
in Schedule II attached hereto.


