

INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

AMENDMENT, dated as of July 2, 1984, by and between THE ATLANTIC LAND AND IMPROVEMENT COMPANY ("AL&I") and SEABOARD SYSTEM RAILROAD, INC. ("SBD").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties hereto have entered into an Interim Use Agreement dated as of March 1, 1984, pursuant to which AL&I permitted SBD to use twenty-eight (28) locomotives owned by AL&I pending completion of financing arrangements by SBD;

WHEREAS, the Interim Use Agreement was filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to 49 U.S.C. Section 11303 on March 29, 1984 and assigned Recordation No. 14302;

WHEREAS, by an Amendment dated as of May 31, 1984 to the Interim Use Agreement, the parties extended the Interim Use Agreement until August 31, 1984, or the date of payment of the purchase price of the locomotives, whichever is earlier;

WHEREAS, the Amendment dated as of May 31, 1984 to the Interim Use Agreement was filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to 49 U.S.C. Section 11303 on May 30, 1984 and assigned Recordation No. 14302-A;

WHEREAS, the parties desire to further amend the Interim Use Agreement to include seven (7) additional Model SD-50 locomotives bearing road numbers SBD 8596-8602, inclusive.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto hereby agree to amend the Interim Use Agreement dated as of March 1, 1984, as amended, to include seven (7) Model SD-50 locomotives bearing road numbers SBD 8596-8602, inclusive.
