

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

WHEREAS RepublicBank Houston, National Association, formerly known as Houston National Bank (hereinafter called "Bank") lent certain monies to one Carroll Tharp (hereinafter called "Tharp") and to secure the repayment of said monies Tharp granted to Bank a security interest in the following described property:
