WHEREAS, GREENVILLE STEEL CAR COMPANY, a Pennsylvania corporation ("Greenville"), and BT EQUIPMENT LEASING, INC., a New York corporation (the "Lessor"), entered into an Equipment Lease dated as of September 1, 1977 (the "Lease"), providing for the lease to Greenville of 20 All Steel 100-Ton High Cube Box Cars, Road Nos. MILW 4787 to 4806 inclusive; and

WHEREAS, Greenville now wishes to amend the Lease so as to substitute Greenville Leasing Company, a Delaware corporation ("Leasing"), as Lessee under the Lease; Leasing is willing to become, and be substituted for Greenville as, Lessee thereunder; Lessor is willing to agree to the said substitution; and the parties hereto desire to enter into this Novation Agreement in order to effectuate the foregoing;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the receipt of good and valuable consideration including the mutual promises hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto, intending to be legally bound hereby, do hereby agree as follows, effective as of December 31, 1980 (the "Effective Date"):

1. Novation. As of the Effective Date, Leasing shall become and be substituted for Greenville as Lessee under the Lease; Leasing agrees to perform all obligations of the Lessee

which shall arise or accrue after the Effective Date, including, without limitation, the recording of this Novation Agreement as required by Section 27 of the Lease; Leasing shall be entitled to all rights of the Lessee under the Lease which shall arise or accrue after the Effective Date; and neither Greenville nor Pittsburgh Forgings Company, as Guarantor, shall be liable in any way to the Lessor for the performance or non-performance of the obligations of the Lessee under the Lease which shall arise or accrue after the Effective Date.

2. General. Each and every other provision, term or condition of the Lease will remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

3. The Lessor hereby consents to the terms and conditions of this Novation Agreement.
