

RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST  
INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION  
(S. C. L. Trust No. 10)

WHEREAS, under the Lease of Railroad Equipment dated as of August 26, 1968 between Ben Maushardt and D. E. Mundell Co-Trustees under a Trust Agreement dated as of August 26, 1968 (the "Trustee") and Seaboard Coast Line Railroad Company (S. C. L.), S. C. L. acquired the possession and use of the railroad equipment described in Schedule I to the Lease Agreement and the Security Agreement; and

WHEREAS, under the Chattel Mortgage, Assignment of Rents and Security Agreement (the "Mortgage") dated as of November 20, 1968 which was filed December 4, 1968 with the Interstate Commerce Commission and assigned ICC recordation Number 6011 from the Trustee (the "Mortgagor") to Provident Mutual Life Insurance Company of Philadelphia (the "Mortgagee"), the Mortgagor conveyed, warranted, mortgaged, pledged and granted to the Mortgagee a Security Interest to the equipment to secure payment of a certain 7.375% Secured Note dated December 4, 1968 maturing on June 4, 1986; and

WHEREAS, on or about June 4, 1986 all principal and interest on said Note has been paid to the Mortgagee; and

WHEREAS, the Trustee wishes to sell the equipment described in Schedule I to the Lease Agreement and the Security Agreement upon the Lease expiration;

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration received, the Mortgagee relinquishes all right, title and interest in and to the equipment.
