
RELEASE AND SATISFACTION AND BILL OF SALE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that First Pennsylvania Bank N.A. (formerly The First Pennsylvania Banking and Trust Company), (the "Trustee"), Trustee under an Equipment Trust Agreement dated as of January 1, 1969, as supplemented (the "Agreement"), between the Trustee and Norfolk and Western Railway Company (the "Railroad"), providing for the formation of Norfolk and Western Railway Equipment Trust, Series Q (the "Equipment Trust"), hereby certifies that all of the principal of the Trust Certificates and dividend warrants attached thereto issued under the Equipment Trust have been fully paid and that all of the obligations of the Railroad under the Agreement have been fully complied with and performed.

WHEREFORE, in consideration of \$1.00 and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Trustee hereby declares the Agreement to be satisfied and canceled, consents that the same be discharged of record, hereby sells, assigns, conveys, transfers, sets over, releases and quitclaims unto the Railroad, as its absolute property, all of the Trustee's right, title and interest in and to the railroad equipment subject to the Equipment Trust and releases the Railroad from any and all obligations of the Agreement.
