

TO MASTER CAR AGREEMENT NO. 11673 INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

IT IS HEREBY AGREED THAT, effective April 1, 1982, this Eighth Rider shall become a part of Master Car Agreement No. 11673 dated February 7, 1974, between TRANSPORTATION CORPORATION OF AMERICA ("TCA") and CANADIAN FOREST PRODUCTS, LTD. ("CANFOR") which was filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission on February 15, 1974, with assigned recordation No. 7399, and which has been filed with the Register General of Canada pursuant to the provisions of the Railway Act on February 22, 1974, at 1:20 p.m. TCA and CANFOR intend that the hereinafter described portion of the railway equipment which is the subject of the said Master Car Agreement, be excluded and removed from the terms, provisions and effect of that Master Car Agreement.

- 1. The Master Car Agreement No. 11673 Rider No. 2, dated April 1, 1977, which was recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission on August 4, 1977, with assigned Recordation No. 7399A, is hereby modified to exclude and remove from the terms, provisions and effects of the Master Car Agreement the following described units of railway equipment:

Twenty-three (23)	100-Ton Thrall-Door Cars	TCAX 20231, TCAX 20233 thru TCAX 20245, both inclusive, and TCAX 20247 thru TCAX 20255, both inclusive

- 2. That as to all other units of railway equipment which are the subject of the Master Car Agreement, that Master Car Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
