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



NOTICE OF RENUMBERING

INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

RECITALS:

1. Greyhound Leasing & Financial Corporation, as Lessor, and Detroit, Toledo and Ironton Railroad Company ("DT&I"), as Lessee, entered into a lease agreement ("Lease"), dated as of November 16, 1973, for the lease of various items of railroad rolling stock, which lease was recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to 49 U.S.C. §11303 (formerly §20 c), on November 19, 1973, and assigned recordation No. 7240. Said lease was subsequently supplemented on several occasions including a supplement dated as of August 1, 1975, and a schedule 4, dated as of August 5, 1975, both of which were recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission on August 4, 1975, and assigned recordation Nos. 7240-C and 7240-D, respectively. Among the items leased pursuant to said supplement and schedule 4 were eight locomotives.

2. Said locomotives are eight GP 38-2 diesel electric locomotives, numbered 221 through 228, both inclusive.

3. Pursuant to said Lease, DT&I may renumber said locomotives by obtaining permission of the Lessor (which permission has been obtained) and recording the new numbers in those offices where the original agreement was recorded.

NOW, THEREFORE, DT&I serves notice that said locomotives will be renumbered as shown on Schedule A, attached hereto and made a part hereof but the locomotives shall otherwise remain subject to all the terms and conditions of the above referenced agreement.
