

THIS RELEASE dated as of December 23, 1987 is made by Harriscorp Leasing Inc. whose post office address is 111 West Monroe Street, Chicago, Illinois 60690 (the "Secured Party").

RECITALS:

A. The Debtor and Arthur Rubloff, deceased, (the "Debtor") have entered into a Loan Agreement dated as of January 15, 1980 (the "Loan Agreement") pursuant to which the Secured Party made a loan (the "Loan") to the Debtor.

B. NOW, THEREFORE, the Secured Party hereby releases the lien and security interest of the Security Agreement as amended by the Amendment in the Equipment.


