This refers to the Loan and Security Agreement (Series E) (the "Agreement") dated as of November 1, 1980, between Union Tank Car Company, 90 Half Day Road, Lincolnshire, Illinois 60015 (the "Company") and Manufacturers Hanover Trust Company, 350 Park Avenue, New York, New York 10022 (the "Bank"). The Agreement was filed with your office on November 12, 1980, and assigned recordation number 12401.

The Agreement was amended as of July 28, 1981 by Amendment No. 2 thereto to evidence the substitution under the Agreement of 1,230 railroad cars described in Schedule A attached thereto for the 1,382 railroads cars described in Schedule A to the Agreement (as heretofore amended). An original and two certified counterparts of such amendment are included herewith for recordation pursuant to 49 U.S.C. §11303.

RELEASE

This Release is executed as of the 28th day of July, 1981, by Manufacturers Hanover Trust Company, a New York banking corporation having its principal place of business at 350 Park Avenue, New York, New York 10022 (the "Bank") in connection with the Loan and Security Agreement dated as of November 1, 1980 (Series E) (the "Agreement") between the Bank and Union Tank Car Company, a Delaware corporation having its principal place of business at 90 Half Day Road, Lincolnshire, Illinois 60015 (the "Company").

1. Purpose. Pursuant to the provisions of the Agreement, which was recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission on November 12, 1980, and assigned recordation number 12401, the Company has granted to the Bank a security interest in certain rail cars (such cars being hereinafter referred to as the "Equipment"), to and in favor of the Bank to secure the payment of the note issued under the Agreement. As provided for in Section 2.09 of the Agreement, the Company has made a partial prepayment of the Equipment Notes issued under the Agreement and, as provided for in Section 3.09 of the Agreement, the Company has delivered to the Bank a request that it be allowed to substitute other rail cars for certain of the units of Equipment more fully described on Schedule A attached to the Agreement (as amended prior to the date hereof). The purpose of this Release is to clearly indicate of record that the Bank has no further interest in the Equipment listed on Schedule A attached to the Agreement (as amended prior to the date hereof), it being the intent of the Bank to release such units of Equipment from any encumbrance of the Bank.

2. Release. The Bank hereby certifies that it has assigned to the Company all of its right, title and interest in and to all of the Equipment more fully described in Schedule A attached to the Agreement (as amended prior to the date hereof) and that it hereby releases such Equipment from any encumbrance with respect thereto in favor of the Bank.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Bank has caused this Release to be executed and its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed by its duly authorized officers as of the date first above written.


