





With respect only to the Cars covered by Schedule No. 2, Section 10.3 is amended in its entirety and a new Section 9.4 is added to the provisions of the Car Lease dated October 29, 1980, both Sections to read as follows:

10.3 Markings; Repainting. Lessee shall, upon initial delivery of the Cars, promptly remove existing markings and place its markings thereon at no cost to Lessor. If Lessor designates a line other than Lessee's line for redelivery, Lessor shall bear the expense of removing Lessee's markings and placing new markings thereon. If the Car is on the Lessee's line, or is subsequently returned to Lessee's line, Lessee shall at Lessor's expense within five (5) working days remove Lessee's markings from the Car and place thereon such markings as maybe designated by Lessor. Such expense shall not exceed the AAR standard rate in effect at that time.

9.4 Optional Removal of Schedule No. 2 Cars. Lessor may, at any time upon 21 days written notice to Lessee, terminate this Agreement as to any Car covered by Schedule No. 2 and direct its return as provided in Section 10; provided, however, Lessor may not exercise its rights under this Section 9.4 more than twice during the Term nor with respect to more than a total of 15 Cars.




