TERMINATION AGREEMENT AND RELEASE

WHEREAS, Emons Industries, Inc. ("Emons") and The Chase Manhattan Bank, N.A. ("Chase") are party to a Chattel Mortgage, Assignment and Security Agreement (the "Agreement") dated as of February 13, 1979 covering two (2) 50 foot, 70 ton wood lined boxcars bearing reporting marks and numbers MPA 7388 and MPA 7393 (the "Cars").

1. Termination. The Agreement is terminated and the cars are released from the liens, assignment and security interest created thereunder.


2. Filing. The parties consent to the filing of this Agreement and any other necessary documents with the Interstate Commerce Commission (and, if necessary, with any




