INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

RIDER NO. 9157704 TO LEASE AGREEMENT NO. 91577 SAID LEASE AGREEMENT BEING DATED September 15, 1977

It is hereby agreed that this Rider shall become a part of the aforementioned Lease Agreement which was filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission on November 15, 1977, with assigned Recordation No. 9089, and supercedes Rider No. 9157702 dated January 3, 1978, (I.C. Recordation No. 9089A, filed February 16, 1978) and that the following described cars shall be placed in the hereinafter identified service subject to the terms and conditions of said Lease Agreement modified so as to include the following:

- CAR NUMBERS: WP 1451 thru WP 1490, both inclusive
- CAR OWNER'S MARKS: Title to this car subject to documents filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission.
- CLASS OF CAR: Bulkhead Flat Car
- NO. OF CARS: Forty
- TRUCK CAPACITY: 100 - Ton
- RENTAL TERM: Thirty-six months immediately following expiration of Rider No. 9157702
- FIXED RENTAL: Four Hundred Ninety-Three and 34/100 dollars (\$493.34) per car, per month for thirty six (36) consecutive months immediately following expiration of Rider No. 9157702 subject to maintenance escalation as defined hereafter.
- MAINTENANCE ESCALATION: Commencing January 1, 1984, on renewal of this agreement, maintenance will be escalated in direct proportion to the published AAR Interchange Rate. Our Rental Rate will increase \$1.01 per car, per month for each one percent (1%), or fraction thereof, increase in the AAR Rate over the \$34.08 per hour rate in effect July 1, 1980.
- OPTION TO RENEW: At expiration of this rental term, LESSEE shall have the option to renew this Agreement. Notice of the exercise of this option shall be given, in writing, by the LESSEE to the LESSOR at least ninety (90) days prior to expiration of this Agreement.
- TERMINATION: LESSEE may, by giving one hundred and twenty (120) days written notice, terminate this Rider. Such termination, however, will not be effective until this Rider has been in effect two years.
