INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

SUPPLEMENT NO. 5, dated as of January 1, 1985, to the Equipment Trust Agreement, dated as of March 1, 1978, as amended (the "Agreement"), between The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, a Delaware corporation (the "Company"), and Harris Trust and Savings Bank, an Illinois corporation (the "Trustee"), whereby The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company Equipment Trust, Series N, is created.

WHEREAS, the Company desires to cause the additional equipment described below to be acquired by the Trustee; and

WHEREAS, Sections 3.1 and 4.2 of the Agreement provide for acquisitions of such additional equipment upon the terms therein set forth;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

1. In accordance with Section 4.2 of the Agreement, the Company shall cause the following items of new standard gauge railroad equipment (the "Additional Equipment") to be transferred to the Trustee, and hereby assigns to the Trustee all of the Company's rights, titles and interests in the Additional Equipment to be acquired:

2. In accordance with Sections 3.1 and 4.2 of the Agreement, the Additional Equipment is hereby included as a part of the Trust Equipment, subject to all terms and conditions of the Agreement in all respects, and the Additional Equipment is hereby leased by the Trustee to the Company.

3. The Agreement is hereby amended by substituting a new Schedule A, revised in accordance with this Supplement, for the present Schedule A, reflecting the additional equipment to be included in the Agreement. A copy of the revised Schedule A is attached hereto as Exhibit 1.




