RELEASE OF CONDITIONAL SALE AGREEMENT

This RELEASE is dated as of December 19, 1980 by CONTINENTAL ILLINOIS NATIONAL BANK AND TRUST COMPANY OF CHICAGO, a national banking association (the "Agent"), having its principal office at 30 North LaSalle Street, Chicago, Illinois 60695 acting as Agent pursuant to a Finance Agreement dated as of February 1, 1978 among the Agent, National Railway Utilization Company, Pickens Railway Company and the Institutional Investors named in Schedule 1 thereto.

W I T N E S S E T H:



NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises the Agent hereby releases all liens, security interest and other rights, titles and interests it possesses or holds in the Equipment pursuant to the Conditional Sale Agreement and the Agreement and Assignment.
