

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



RELEASE OF LIEN

INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT;

WHEREAS, NATIONAL NEWARK & ESSEX BANK not individually but solely as trustee (the "Trustee") under Milwaukee Road Trust No. 73-4 under Trust Agreement dated as of May 15, 1973 has heretofore executed and delivered its Conditional Sale Agreement dated as of May 15, 1973 (the "Original Agreement") to GENERAL MOTORS CORPORATION (ELECTRO-MOTIVE DIVISION), a Delaware corporation ("GM"), PACCAR, INC., a Delaware corporation ("PACCAR"), BETHLEHEM STEEL CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation ("Bethlehem") and CHICAGO, MILWAUKEE, ST. PAUL AND PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY, a Wisconsin corporation ("Railroad"); and

WHEREAS, GM, PACCAR and Bethlehem have heretofore executed and delivered the Agreement and Assignment dated as of May 15, 1973 ("Assignment") with Wells Fargo Bank, N.A., as agent and assignee ("Wells Fargo"); and

WHEREAS, the Original Agreement was amended by the First Amendment to Conditional Sale Agreement dated as of February 1, 1980 (the "Amendment") among the Trustee (then known as Midatlantic National Bank), Richard B. Ogilvie, Trustee of the Property of the Railroad and Wells Fargo (the Original Agreement, as amended by the Amendment, is hereinafter referred to as the "Conditional Sale Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, Wells Fargo, under an instrument of Resignation, Appointment & Acceptance dated as of May 1, 1985 (the "Resignation"), resigned as agent and assignee under the Assignment and related instruments and appointed Manufacturers Hanover Trust Company (the "Agent") as its successor, and

WHEREAS, the Original Agreement was filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to 49 U.S.C. Sec. 11303 on June 26, 1973, under Recordation Number 7080, the Assignment was filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to 49 U.S.C. Sec. 11303 on July 20, 1973, under Recordation Number 7080-A, the Amendment was filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to 49 U.S.C. Sec. 11303 on June 6, 1980, under Recordation Number 7080-B, and the Resignation was filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to 49 U.S.C. Sec. 11303 on April 8, 1986, under Recordation Number 7080-C; and

WHEREAS, the Trustee (now known as Midatlantic National Bank) has requested the Agent to release from the lien of the Conditional Sale Agreement (i) the 100 50' Cushion Underframe Box Cars, MILW Road Numbers 56500 to 56599, both inclusive, (ii) the 100 60' Cushion Underframe Box Cars, MILW Road Numbers 6300 to 6399, both inclusive, and (iii) the 50 100-ton Ballast Cars, MILW Road Numbers 341400 to 341449, both inclusive (collectively

hereinafter called the "Released Equipment"), and has complied with all conditions of the Conditional Sale Agreement precedent to such release.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Agent, for and in consideration of \$10.00 and other good and valuable consideration, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledge, does hereby RELEASE and CONVEY unto the Trustee, its successors and assigns, all of the rights, title, lien, security interest or claim whatsoever which the Agent has or may have acquired under, through or by virtue of the Conditional Sale Agreement in and to the Released Equipment.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Agent has caused this instrument to be duly executed and delivered by its duly authorized officer as of this 17TH day of January, 1989.
