

PARTIAL RELEASE OF RAILCAR LIEN

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT:

WHEREAS, UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY, a Utah corporation (the "Railroad"), has heretofore obtained an Order dated September 7, 1995 from the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois ("Order") in Union Pacific Railroad Company vs. TEMCO Leasing Company, Case No. 94 C 6225; and

WHEREAS, the Railroad duly filed and recorded a Memorandum of Order (the "Memorandum of Order") with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to 49 U.S.C. § 11303 on October 19, 1995 under recordation number 19672; and

WHEREAS, TEMCO Leasing Company ("TEMCO") has requested that the Railroad release from its judgement lien, certain property subject to the Memorandum of Order hereinafter particularly described.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Railroad, for and in consideration of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other good and valuable consideration, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby RELEASE, REMISE, CONVEY AND QUIT CLAIM unto TEMCO, its successors and assigns, all of the right, title, lien, interest, claim or demand whatsoever which the Railroad has or may have acquired under, through or by virtue of the Memorandum of Order in and to the property described in Appendix A hereto.

THIS INSTRUMENT is executed upon the express condition that nothing herein contained shall be construed to release from the lien of the Memorandum of Order, or to impair said lien upon any property subject thereto, except the property hereinabove specifically described.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Railroad has caused this instrument to be duly executed and delivered by its duly authorized officers as of this 7 day of June, 1996.


