





This Release of Lien of Railroad Equipment Lease (the "Release") releases the lien created by that certain Railroad Equipment Lease dated as of October 8, 1998, bearing Recordation No. 20850, between DJJ Transportation Services, Inc., as Lessor ("Lessor") and United States Gypsum Company, as Lessee ("Lessee"), as subsequently amended by Amendment No. 1 to the Railroad Equipment Lease dated March 6, 1998 bearing Recordation No. 20850-A and Amendment No. 2 to the Railroad Equipment Lease dated June 3, 1998 bearing Recordation No. 20850-B (such Lease and Amendments hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Lease") with respect to 20 railcars as shown in Exhibit A attached hereto (hereinafter, the "Equipment").

WHEREAS, Lessor and Lessee executed the Lease relating to the Equipment. Such Lease expired effective June 30, 1999.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Lessor submits the following:

1. The Lease has expired effective June 30, 1999.
2. This Release shall be recorded with the Surface Transportation Board so as to record the release of the lien against the Equipment constituted by the Lease.


