RELEASE OF LIEN
OF
LEASE AGREEMENT

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This Release of Lease Agreement Lien (the "Release") releases the lien created by that certain Lease Agreement dated as of January 7, 1998 (the "Lease"), bearing Recordation No. 21217 dated February 18, 1998, between DJJ Transportation Services, Inc., as Lessor ("Lessor") and Willamette & Pacific Railroad, as Lessee ("Lessee"), with respect to 100 railcars, WPRR 73000-73099, inclusive (hereinafter, the "Equipment").

WHEREAS, Lessor and Lessee executed the Lease Agreement relating to the Equipment. Such Lease Agreement expired April 30, 1998; and

2. All interest of the Lessee, its successors and assigns, in the Equipment arising pursuant to the Lease has been terminated.
3. The Lessor hereby releases any lien created by or arising out of the Lease.
4. This Release shall be recorded with the Surface Transportation Board so as to record the release of the lien against the Equipment constituted by the Lease.
