

**AMENDMENT TO  
LEASE AGREEMENT**

INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

This amendment to the Lease Agreement (the "Amendment"), is entered into this 3rd day of June, 1994, by and between The David J. Joseph Company ("Lessor") and Iowa Interstate Railroad ("Lessee"), amending that certain Lease Agreement (the "Lease") dated February 17, 1994, by and between Lessor and Lessee.

WHEREAS, the Lease was duly filed for recordation with the Interstate Commerce Commission ("ICC") on February 28, 1994, with recordation number 18723.

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Lease commencement date from March 24, 1994 to May 15, 1994, for all twenty (20) Cars, which are the subject of the Lease.

WHEREAS, the parties further desire to amend the Lease by increasing the monthly base rental from [REDACTED] per Car, per month, to [REDACTED] per Car, per month. All other terms and conditions of the Lease shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

The Lease is amended by changing the Lease commencement date to May 15, 1994, for all Cars which are subject to this Lease. The Lease is further amended by increasing the monthly base rental from [REDACTED] per Car, per month, to [REDACTED] per Car, per month. All other terms and conditions of the Lease remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
