The Owner Trustee and Burlington Northern Railroad Company ("*Lessee*") have entered into an Equipment Lease Agreement (BN 1994-F), dated as of September 15, 1994, and Lease Supplement No. 1 thereto, dated September 29, 1994, covering certain locomotives and railcars bearing reporting marks as listed on Exhibit A attached hereto.


