I am counsel to Trinity Industries Leasing Company (the "Company") and, in particular, handled the above referenced matter. Since the original filing at the ICC on December 27, 1984, the Company has filed a number of documents, including those associated with supplements to the original Equipment Trust Agreement. In that regard, I am enclosing a copy of your First Record Sheet for Recordations that our agent recently obtained for us.



TERMINATION AND RELEASE AGREEMENT

TERMINATION AND RELEASE AGREEMENT dated as of December 21, 1995, between The Bank of New York, as successor trustee (the "Trustee") under an Equipment Trust Agreement, dated as of December 15, 1984 (as amended or restated, the "Trust Agreement"), and Trinity Industries Leasing Company, a Delaware corporation) (the "Company").

PRELIMINARY STATEMENT

Pursuant to the Trust Agreement, the documents described on Schedule 1 attached hereto (the "Trust Documents") were executed and delivered, and recorded as described therein.
