



LEASE SUPPLEMENT NO. 2

INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

This LEASE SUPPLEMENT NO. 2, dated April 30, 1993, between U.S. TRUST COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, N.A., not in its individual capacity but solely as Owner Trustee (the "Lessor") and SOUTHERN PACIFIC TRANSPORTATION COMPANY, a Delaware corporation (the "Lessee");

WITNESSETH:

The Lessor and the Lessee have heretofore entered into that certain Equipment Lease dated as of December 1, 1992 (the "Lease"). The terms used herein have the meanings specified in the Lease.

The Lease provides for the execution and delivery of a Lease Supplement substantially in the form hereof for the purpose of evidencing the lease, delivery and acceptance of Items of Equipment under the Lease.


