INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

THIS PARTIAL TERMINATION OF LEASE, is made as of the 28th day of March, 1996, by and among General Electric Company, a New York corporation acting through its Transportation Systems Business Operation ("GE"), CSX Transportation, Inc., a Virginia corporation ("CSXT"), and The Baltimore and Ohio Chicago Terminal Railroad Company, an Illinois corporation ("Railroad").

WHEREAS, GE, CSXT and Railroad are parties to an Interim User Agreement dated January 22, 1996 (the "Lease"); and

WHEREAS, a Memorandum of the Lease was duly filed for recordation with the Interstate Commerce Commission ("ICC") pursuant to 49 U.S.C. Section 11303, on January 30, 1996, at 10:20 a.m. and given Recordation Number 19915; and

WHEREAS, GE, CSXT and Railroad now desire to terminate and cancel the Lease solely with respect to 11 of the 82 diesel electric locomotives originally covered thereby, and to record such partial termination and cancellation with the ICC;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is acknowledged, Railroad, CSXT and GE, intending to be legally bound, agree as follows:

1. Railroad, CSXT and GE hereby terminate and cancel the Lease, effective March 28, 1996, but solely, with respect to the following equipment: 11 General Electric Company Model AC 4400 Diesel Electric Locomotives bearing Road Numbers 117, 147-154 (inclusive), 163 and 164 (hereinafter, the "Terminated Equipment").
2. The parties agree to record this Partial Termination of Lease with the ICC so as to release GE's lien against the Terminated Equipment.
3. This Partial Termination of Lease may be executed by the parties in one or more counterparts (or upon separate signature pages

- bound together in one or more counterparts) which together shall constitute but one and the same instrument.




