

RELEASE OF RAILCAR LIEN

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT:

WHEREAS, John H. Glenn, 7208 Eagle Ridge Place, Bethesda, Maryland 20817 ("JHG"), has heretofore executed and delivered its security Agreement dated as of December 24, 1980 (the "Security Agreement") to KEY BANK, N.A., a national banking association (the "Bank"), and

WHEREAS, the Security Agreement was duly recorded and filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to 49 U.S.C. ss11303 on December 24, 1980, under Recordation Number 12665; and as extended by modification dated January 23, 1989, and filed on March 23, 1989 under Recordation Number 12665-A.

WHEREAS, JHG has requested the Bank to release its lien in the property of JHG which was created under the Security Agreement and has complied with all conditions of the Security Agreement precedent to such release.

NOW THEREFORE, the Bank, for and in consideration of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other good and valuable consideration, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and pursuant to the authority vested by the Security Agreement in the Bank, does hereby RELEASE, REMISE, CONVEY AND QUIT CLAIM unto JHG, its successors and assigns, all of the right, title, lien, interest, claim or demand whatsoever which the Bank has or may have acquired under, through or by virtue of the Security Agreement, including, but not limited to, all of its right, title, lien and interest in and to the property described in Appendix A Hereto.
